Meeting began at 6:30 pm

One member of the public, Heidi Blotner, was in attendance.

A brief update regarding the maintenance issues for all the Kensington MADs was given by Don Taylor and Bill Adair. Don Taylor reviewed efforts to meet with City Staff regarding electrical charges for the posts; and to get some of the posts evaluated for future repair or replacement.

Discussed whether all the MADs should select the same paint color for the street light posts to give a more uniform look to Kensington.

Priscilla Berge stated that the Marbelite posts did not originally have paint and she would like to see them returned to that natural look. Don Taylor said that he spoke with Labib Qasem, who stated the City would not completely strip down the old posts for both cost and environmental concerns. Priscilla mentioned the possibility of having the posts and/or the parkways declared historic. She stated it is a fairly involved process, which can take considerable time and expertise. The consensus of Kensington Manor and Talmadge Park South was that this issue will require more thought.

Don Taylor stated that Kensington Heights will still need to move forward with a color selection, because the metal posts in that MAD need protection from the elements.

In a general discussion, the color of "Gun Metal Gray" seemed to have the greatest support with some support for a "Light Gray."
