- V. Kensington Manor Action Items:
 - 1) As part of the circuit upgrade, and as funds become available either from the MAD or the City, recommend to the full planning group that the first priority be to replace the cobra light at 4118 Rochester, and the two non-decorative metal “straight poles” at 4191 Rochester and 4134 Lymer.
 - 2) As funds become available either from the MAD or the City, recommend to the full planning group that the second priority be to install the proposed new light post at the end of Norfolk Terrace.
 - 3) As funds become available either from the MAD or the City, recommend to the full planning group that the third priority be to install two cobra lights on 42nd Street at an estimated cost of \$2,500 per light even if those lights are attached to utility poles.
- VI. Kensington Park North Action Items:
 - 1) Recommend to the full planning group that as a first priority they request the use of only subsurface electrical infrastructure to install future light posts on Alder, Terrace, Kensington, Marlborough, and Biona Drives, Edgeware Road, Biona Place, Vista Street, and Vista Lane.
 - 2) Recommend to the full planning group that as a second priority as funds become available either from the MAD or the City, they request that they be used to install 10 foot Aegean Acorn light posts on Edgeware Road.
 - 3) Recommend to the full planning group that as a third priority as funds become available either from the MAD or the City, they request that they be used to install two cobra lights on 42nd Street at an estimated cost of \$2,500 per light even if those lights are attached to utility poles.
